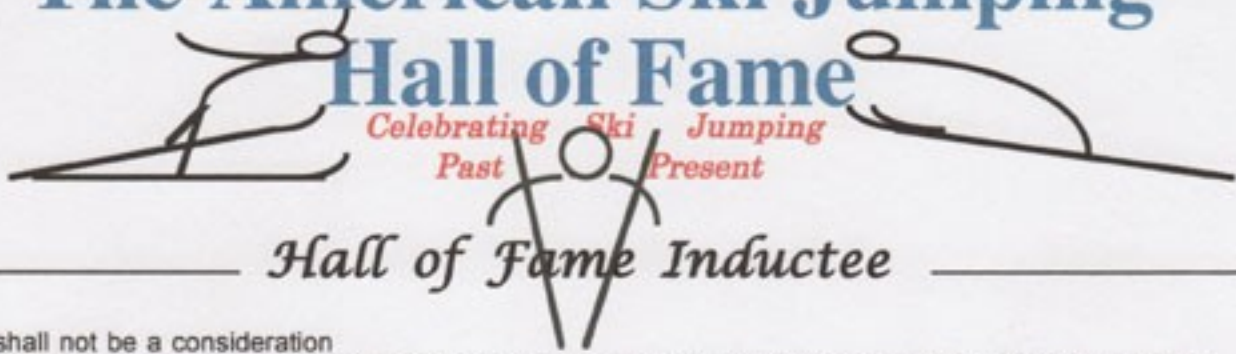


The American Ski Jumping Hall of Fame



Hall of Fame Inductee

Criteria:

- Gender shall not be a consideration
- Athletes who have displayed outstanding ski jumping abilities and have represented the United States in an exemplary and meritorious manner, will be eligible for induction into the American Ski Jumping Hall of Fame.
- Contributions to the sport of ski jumping shall have been significant for a long period of time
- Contributions shall be considered to have a lasting, positive influence over an extended period of time.
- Contributions of the nominee have resulted in a categorical and emphatic influence on the perpetuation and preservation of the sport of ski jumping on a local, regional, national and/or international level.
- Persons will be considered eligible for induction into the American Ski Jumping Hall of Fame if their contributions to the sport of ski jumping were historically, or contemporarily important and those contributions have had a significant impact national to the sport of ski jumping.
