



## **OLE R. MANGSETH**

- 1878** Born in Elverum, Norway. He spent countless hours on skis as a youngster, developing into a top competitor. Immigrated to the U.S. as a young man, settled for most of his life in Coleraine, MN.
- 1900's** Ranked among the top five jumpers in the country for several years but never won a National title.
- 1906** Represented the Aurora Ski Club, at Red Wing, MN for three years.
- 1907** Set a National distance record of 114'.
- 1909** Joined the Coleraine Ski Club, Minnesota. Greatly influenced and coached many young skiers in the Itaska Ski and Outing Club at Coleraine, including his two sons, Ronald and Rolf, past National Boy Ski Jumping Champions and Eugene Wilson of Coleraine.
- 1905, 1906, 1909, 1910** Placed in the top four in National tournaments.
- 1925-1928** Served as Treasurer for the National Ski Association.  
Worked for the U.S. Ski Association.
- 1952** Died September 24<sup>th</sup> at the age of 74.
- 1968** Inducted into the National Ski Hall of Fame in Ishpeming, MI.
